How to Report Suspicious Messages – Outlook Mobile

Why Should I Use It?

When Do I Use It?

Click the **Report Phishing** add-in if you think you received a phishing email or any potentially dangerous email. Any emails you report using the REPORT PHISHING add-in will be automatically deleted from your inbox. The emails you report will also be sent to MI|HSOC for analysis.



MI|HSOC is a cyber-defense partnership between Munson Healthcare, Michigan Medicine, Metro Health and many others. Reported emails are monitored 24/7 and you will receive a response to every message reported.

The REPORT PHISHING should only be used to report <u>emails you believe to have</u> <u>malicious intent</u>. If you are receiving spam or marketing emails, open your Mimecast Personal Portal (<u>Personal Portal</u>), select Blocked, Add Blocked. Instructions are found in the daily Spam Digest email.

How Do I Use It?

Depending on your device, the steps for reporting an email using the Report Phishing addin may vary. However, the steps below cover the most common mobile operating systems and the basic steps should be similar.

- Outlook Mobile App (iOS)
- Outlook Mobile App (Android)

If you report an email in error, you can retrieve the email from your Deleted Items.

Outlook Mobile App (iOS)

To report an email:

- 1. Click on the suspicious message to be reported
- 2. Tap the three dots at the top-right of the message (under the time and date)







1. Open the suspicious email, tap the three dots at the top-right of the email (under the date.




